South Sudan Emergency Appeal Launched

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God... Matthew 5:9

Alarmed at the growing humanitarian crisis in South Sudan, the United Church is issuing a church-wide appeal. Donations will aid displaced persons with food, water, shelter and medicine. Mission & Service partners are already on the ground in refugee camps serving those in need.
