A big Thank you to everyone who helped with our annual Harvest Supper and to all those who bought a ticket and came to eat all the great food.

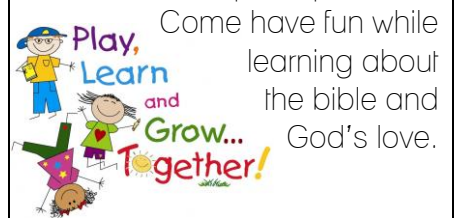
Helping Hand

Come have fun while learning about the bible and God's love.

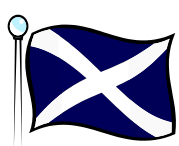
