Fall Supper is being planned for Saturday, November 1.



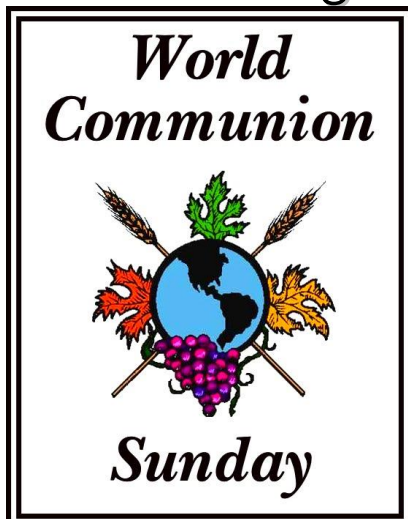
